## Memory Verses for Journey #8

### Lesson 1: The Geography of Palestine

**MATTHEW 4:13-14a**—“And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet....”

### Lesson 2: The Regions of Palestine

**MATTHEW 4:25**—“Great multitudes followed Him—from Galilee, and from Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan.”

### Lesson 3: Jerusalem

**LUKE 24:47**—“And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.”

### Lesson 4: Languages of the Bible

**LUKE 23:38**—“And an inscription also was written over Him in letters of Greek, Latin, and Hebrew: *THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.*”

### Lesson 5: Biblical Social and Ethnic Groups

**JOHN 4:9**—“Then the woman of Samaria said to Him, ‘How is it that You, being a Jew, ask a drink from me, a Samaritan woman?’ For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.”

### Lesson 6: Professions in Bible Times

**MATTHEW 4:18-20**—“And Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. Then He said to them, ‘Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.’ They immediately left their nets and followed Him.”

### Lesson 7: Dwelling Places in Bible Times

**MATTHEW 8:20**—“And Jesus said to him, ‘Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head.’”

### Lesson 8: Foods of the Bible

**JOHN 6:35**—“And Jesus said to them, ‘I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.’”

### Lesson 9: Jewish Feasts and Festivals

**ACTS 2:1**—“When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.”

### Lesson 10: Animals of the Bible

**JOHN 10:11**—“I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.”

### Lesson 11: Clothing in Bible Times

**1 PETER 3:3-4**—“Do not let your adornment be merely outward—arranging the hair, wearing gold, or putting on fine apparel—rather let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God.”
